Directions: The park is located 1 mile south of Livingston on US Highway 59, 4 miles west on FM 1988, 1/2 mile north on FM 3126 to Park Road 65, which is 70 miles from Kuehnle. The route is marked with brown "Lake Livingston State Park" signs.

Activities: Camping, nature study, bird watching, fishing, hiking, and biking. Saturday night. Plan B" bring a board game in case of rain.

Fees: There is a \$4 per person (over 13) entrance fee at the gate. The campsite has already been paid for by the Pack.
